



## Financial Aid Newsletter Spring Registration 2021

**IS THERE A FINANCIAL AID DEADLINE FOR SPRING REGISTRATION? YES!** To guarantee the use of financial aid for Spring registration, you must have submitted all documentation as requested to the Financial Aid Office by **November 2, 2020**. Processing of award letters will continue on a regular basis for students completing their files. **However, eligible students who do not receive an e-mail notification to their Mitchell account about viewing their award on WebAdvisor by December 10, 2020 should plan to pay their tuition/fees to secure their SPRING registration class schedule. E-cashiering is available on the Mitchell website to access payment plan.**

**WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PAY WITH FINANCIAL AID?** If you **RECEIVE an e-mail notification about your 2020-2021 award letter** from the Financial Aid Office at Mitchell Community College **before December 10, 2020**, your tuition and fees will automatically be paid by financial aid with **NO ACTION** required on your part.

**WHEN CAN I USE FINANCIAL AID TO CHARGE AT THE BOOKSTORE?** You may charge books and supplies **January 5-8, 11-15, 19-22 and January 25, 2021 for classes starting January 11, 2021**. We encourage you to attend class before purchasing your textbooks. This helps to reduce the number of returns and refunds that must be processed by our Bookstore. Please limit the number of trips you make to the Bookstore to two (2). You may charge one item of clothing **IF** you are registered for a PE class only. You may also charge one (1) book bag, if needed. **A picture ID and a printed schedule of classes is needed to make purchases.**

**WHAT IF I DROP/ADD?** If you participate in **drop/add January 11-13, 2021**, you will be able to charge additional books and/or supplies if needed.

**WHEN WILL MY FINANCIAL AID CHECK BE AVAILABLE?** The remaining balance, after tuition, fees and Bookstore charges have been deducted, **will be mailed on February 19, 2021 from Financial Services to the address listed with the Admissions Office, NOT the address you listed on your FAFSA**. Remember you **MUST** keep your address current with the Admissions Office. A check **will not be re-issued** until Mitchell Community College has received the returned check due to an insufficient address.

### Important Information

- If you totally withdraw from all your classes, you may be responsible for the repayment of Pell Grant, FSEOG, and/or state funds under R2T4.
- You must be attending all classes through the 60% point of each course (Example: the 60% point for a 16-week class is March 29, 2021) to be entitled to your Financial Aid. If you are a "no show" in class(es), your financial aid will be calculated based on the number of hours you are currently attending and you will be charged 100% tuition for the "no show."
- Financial aid will only pay for courses required in your program of study.
- You are not eligible to receive financial aid from more than one institution during the same semester within the same academic year.

If you register for short session classes with a start date later than January 11, 2021, your financial aid will be calculated based on the number of hours you are currently attending. Any remaining financial aid for the short session class(es) may be awarded once your entrance into class(es) is confirmed.
