Dear Student,

Congratulations! You are one step closer to completing your degree at Mitchell Community College! If you are unsure of your graduation eligibility for spring, please consult with your advisor.

Mitchell's 2023 Graduation Commencement will be held at the Mooresville Performing Arts Center, Saturday, May 13, 2023. There will be two ceremonies, 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. You will only need to attend one. There will be a sign up for the ceremony you wish to attend on the Commencement website as we get closer to the graduation date.

Following are four important things you need to know prior to graduation day:

1. The cost of the cap, gown and tassel set is \$35.13 plus \$2.37 tax=\$37.50. The set will be available for purchase from the College Bookstore beginning on **February 13**. All purchases are final.
2. Graduation announcements and diploma frames are available for purchase at the College Bookstore.

Monday – Thursday.....8:30 a.m.-5 p.m.

Friday.....8:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. with no evening hours

3. Class ring information and sales: There will be a flyer sent by email to all prospective Mitchell Community College graduates advertising a new event for purchasing class rings. Please check your Mitchell email in March to sign up for a one on one time with the sales representative from Herff Jones.
4. Summer graduates that wish to walk in the May Commencement ceremony must register for Summer 2023 courses by **April 14, 2023**. If you do not wish to walk in the May Commencement ceremony, you may register for your courses through the end of the registration period. Summer graduates who want to walk in the May 2023 Commencement ceremony must notify the Registrar's Office that they plan on walking by emailing graduation@mitchellcc.edu by **April 17, 2023**. Print material for the ceremony will be sent out the following week. Failing to email by the stated deadline will result in the student's name not being published in the Commencement Program, as well as not having a name card for announcement during the ceremony.
