



Title IX Resources

Mitchell Community College encourages those who experience sexual harassment and sexual misconduct to report it directly to the Mitchell Community College Title IX coordinator, or deputy Title IX coordinator. These individuals will support and provide you with information regarding options, including grievance procedures, interim remedies, and ongoing emotional support. They will assist in supporting you, eliminating the misconduct, preventing its occurrence, and addressing its effects.

As required by federal law, all College employees who become aware of any alleged incident of sex discrimination, including sexual harassment, sexual violence or assault, sexual misconduct or other sex or gender-based discrimination must notify the Title IX coordinator or a deputy Title IX coordinator. The Title IX coordinator, deputy Title IX coordinator are charged with investigating and responding to allegations of sexual misconduct. Mitchell Community College will seek to maintain your privacy at all times during the process. Reports of sexual assault will be shared only with individuals on a need-to-know basis or as required by law.
