

## **Graduation and Transfer-Out Rates**

The Student-Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act (P.L. 101-542) mandates that all institutions participating in Title IV or HEA programs disclose graduation and transfer-out rates to current and prospective students.

In compliance, Mitchell Community College followed 304 first-time, full-time college students who enrolled in a degree, diploma or certificate programs in Fall 2016. Of that group of students:

26%	Graduated within 3 years
19%	Transferred to another institution prior to graduation
10%	Are still enrolled at Mitchell

## **Retention Rates**

Mitchell Community College tracked 304 first-time, full-time college students enrolled in Fall 2016 and determined that 57% of these students either returned to the College in Fall 2017 or completed a program. The College also tracked 155 first-time, part-time college students enrolled in Fall 2016 and determined that 40% of these students had either returned to the College in Fall 2017 or completed a program.
