

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) II Reporting Emergency Financial Aid Grants

- 1. Mitchell Community College acknowledges the College executed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement under Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), with assurance to spend the same dollar amount on student grants as required to spend under the CARES Act.
- 2. The total amount of funds the College has received from the Department pursuant to the College's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students is \$696,513.
- 3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) as of the above date is \$696,513.
- 4. The estimated total number of students at the College eligible to participate in the program under Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants is 1684.
- 5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) as of the above date is 674. The methods used by the College to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants, including how much a student would receive under Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) have been determined. - 6. Students eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants were notified by email and by Exhibit 2 on the College website of the availability of the HEERF II funds to help with expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19.
