

CARES Act Federal Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Reporting— Emergency Financial Aid Grants

- Mitchell Community College acknowledges the College executed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement with assurance to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2. The total amount of funds the College has received from the Department pursuant to the College's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students is \$696,513.
- 3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the above date is \$695,850.
- 4. The estimated total number of students at the College eligible to participate in the programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 1629.
- 5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 10884(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the above date is 1,084. The methods used by the College to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants, including how much a student would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act have been determined. See Exhibit 1.
- 6. Students eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants were notified by email and by Exhibit 1 on the College website of the availability of the CARES Act funds to help with expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19.
