# THE MYRTLE WESTMORELAND MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR HOSPICE NURSING

### PRESENTED BY HOSPICE & PALLIATIVE CARE OF IREDELL COUNTY (HPCIC):

HPCIC has served Iredell and the surrounding communities since 1984. Our mission is to honor life by providing extraordinary care with comfort, compassion and dignity to our patients, families, and community.

#### **PURPOSE:**

The Myrtle Westmoreland Memorial Scholarship for Hospice Nursing was established in 2019 in honor of the founders of Hospice & Palliative Care of Iredell County, Myrtle Westmoreland. This \$5,000 scholarship is intended to offer an opportunity for nursing students at Mitchell Community College who understand and value the mission of hospice and palliative care and embrace providing extraordinary end-of-life care.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must be active/enrolled as a year one, second semester nursing student or rising paramedic to nursing student at Mitchell Community College
- Must be academically motivated
- Must be willing to commit to two years employment with HPCIC as a Registered Nurse following graduation
- Recipient will be required to pay back the granted funds should the employment agreement not be fulfilled

#### **SELECTION PROCESS:**

The HPCIC scholarship committee will review completed applications, invite finalists for an in-person interview and make the final decision on the scholarship recipient. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

#### SCHOLARSHIP FUND DISBURSEMENT:

Scholarship funds are intended for tuition, books exams and course related expenses/fees. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to Awardee in two payments of \$2,500 (\$5,000 over the course of two semesters). The funds will be paid directly to the student without taxation. Student will be responsible for reporting the taxable income.

#### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

All scholarship applications must be completed and submitted by May 29.

Completed applications should include:

- Application form
- Verification of enrollment from Mitchell Community College (unofficial copy of transcript and/or schedule)
- One letter of recommendation from MCC instructors, including one nursing instructor
- 400-word essay
